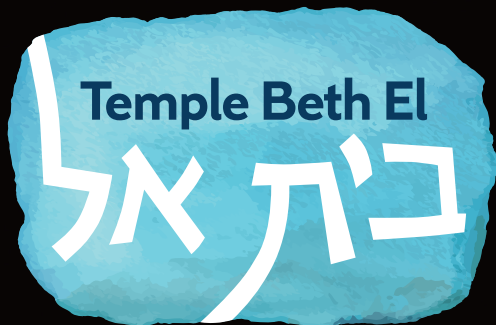

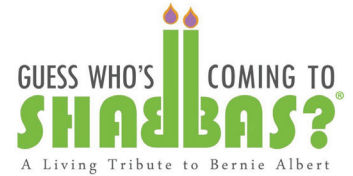




GUESS WHO'S COMING TO SHABBAS?

Dear Fellow Congregants,

We recently began our second cycle of "Guess Who's Coming to Shabbas". We initiated the program at Beth El on November 6, 2015, and we adopted the same goals that the suburban synagogue outside of Philadelphia, the originators of the program, had articulated:



1. To strengthen our synagogue community, and
2. to help families build meaningful Jewish memories.

I'm delighted to tell you that since we initiated the program at least 140 families have participated in the program as either Hosts or Guests. Numerous families have hosted on more than one occasion.

Without exception, every participant with whom I've spoken has thoroughly enjoyed the experience. Our goal for the new cycle is to double or triple the participation, so that ultimately 100% of our congregation has been included.

President's Message

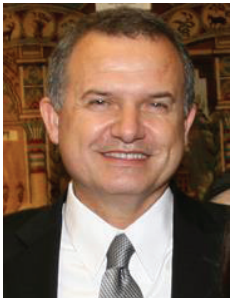

From the Desk of the Senior Rabbi

Limmud, Temple Beth El new Jewish Education Initiative.

I would like to provide a personal overview of our new Limmud Program.

There is a fundamental principle that sustains, motivates and guides our new Limmud initiative - the supreme value of Jewish Education. For the Jewish child, this means growing up to share in the Jewish experiences of his/her family and people as recorded in its sacred literature, traditions and history. For Jewish parents, this means drawing their children closer to themselves by imparting to children those teachings, experiences, ideals and practices which they find meaningful in the Jewish Tradition. It is to these purposes that Limmud of Temple Beth El is dedicated.

We believe our Limmud program provides the experiential opportunity to attain basic knowledge of the Hebrew language, Torah, Jewish holidays; with the skills to actively participate in synagogue life; and with an appreciation of the enduring moral and ethical values that Judaism teaches.

We maintain that moral teachings of Judaism are woven into the texture of Jewish observance and belief.

What is it that we want for our children? We want their Jewishness to be informed and developed with insight, to be accepted with joy, wonder and to be carried with appreciation. We want our children to sense their own personal bond of unity with the Jewish people everywhere, with our brothers and sisters in Israel, and with all humankind.

These are challenging goals to which we pledge our every effort. Our Teachers, Madrichim, special education consultants, under the leadership of Samara Sofian, work together to make our Limmud a center of Torah, a place in which Judaism is not only presented, experienced and taught, but celebrated. We cannot do this task alone. A supportive Jewish home is a necessary element in the Jewish educations of our young. Help us to help your children. Help us to help them to reach adulthood as dedicated, happy and knowledgeable Jews.

I invite you to share your ideas and to participate in the exciting and rewarding experience of Jewish learning and living at Limmud.

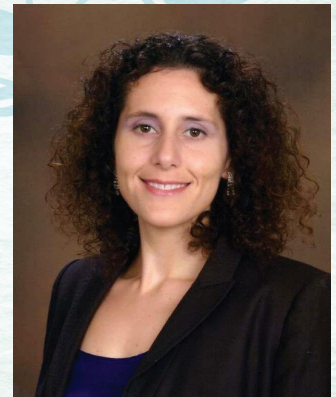

Jewish tradition places a strong emphasis on the value of friendship. Strong friendships enhance our lives and help us to connect to the world around us. Lasting friendships within a community build a stronger community and help the community members remain close to one another.

Helping our youth to build lasting Jewish friendships is part of the design of Limmud: Temple Beth El's Youth Education Program. Built into the program are several key elements that work toward that goal. Each grade-based group has adult Madrichim who plan community building activities during their daily group time. The Madrichim also work throughout their time with the children to help them connect with their peers and encourage friendships that extend beyond the TBE walls. We also work to build community and friendships across the grades. To this goal, we have a monthly Limmud lunch that brings together the whole program. We also have special days like the Yom Sport day that was organized by our Ramah Service Corps Fellows and allowed for an opportunity for children to get to know one another in a different kind of atmosphere. Additionally, we have multi-grade chuggim (electives) that allow children to connect with one another based on an area of interest.

In addition to Limmud, we offer many other opportunities for our children, both those who attend Limmud and Koolanu (our teen program), and those who do not, to form friendships and be together as a community. Our youth and family Shabbat services give the opportunity to come together in prayer. TBE's three youth groups – Halutzim for 3rd-5th graders, Kadima for 6th-8th graders and USY for 9th-12th graders - provide regular opportunities for our children to connect through fun, social, community service and educational activities.

Developing strong friendships within our TBE community is not just for our youth! I encourage everyone to nurture their TBE relationships, building not only an enriched life, but also a stronger community.

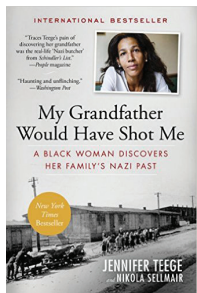

What is mishloach manot?

Why do we send gifts of food to friends on purim?

Purim is coming on March 12. One of the mitzvot of Purim is sending gifts of food, called Mishloach Manot (literally, "the sending of portions") to acquaintances. The obligation is to send a minimum of two ready-to-eat-foods to at least one person.. The source for this mitzvah is in the Megillah. "Mordechai... enjoined the [Jews] to make the fourteenth day of the month of Adar... feasting and joy, and sending portions one to another, and gifts to the poor.

Sisterhood joins the Jewish Living program of the Rochester Kollel and the staff at the JCC to identify adults in the community who welcome gifts of mishloach manot. We assemble packages and see that they are delivered.

Sisterhood also assembles packages for clergy and office staff at Temple Beth El.

Join us on March 13 to assemble packages and send them on their way. You are all welcome. An informal lunch will be served.

Phyllis Korn Wins Farash Prize for Social Entrepreneurship



Each year since 2012 the Farash Foundation has presented **“The Farash Prize for Social Entrepreneurship”** to a grassroots social entrepreneur to honor their accomplishments in our community as well as to bring visibility to their organizations. The prize hopes to encourage others not only to meet needs in our community, but also to reduce those needs over time. Past winners have included the founder of Foodlink, and the Co-Founder of St. Joseph’s Neighborhood Center.

The Farash Prize of Social Entrepreneurship for 2016 was awarded on November 1 to Temple Beth El’s own Phyllis Korn. Phyllis was recognized for her work as Executive Director of Alternatives for Battered Women. ABW opened its first domestic violence shelter in 1979, only the third such facility in New York State. Phyllis also worked with local police agencies and courts to transform their responses to domestic abuse situations. The effect of Phyllis’ work has extended far beyond our own Rochester community, as she was also a founding member of the New York Coalition Against Domestic Violence.

Alternatives for Battered Women is still in service today. It has expanded its capacity and its programming as Willow Domestic Violence Center. The Farash prize not only recognizes Phyllis’ hard work and dedication, but provides a monetary gift to Alternatives for Battered Women so they can continue their important work.

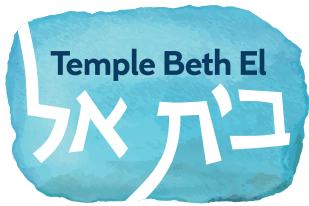
